Better Ramadan 2025

Ramadan is a noble and significant month. It is a month full of blessings, a time to give, whether in terms of wealth, food, or anything else. During the month of Ramadan, Muslims fast. It is estimated that 343 million people are acutely food insecure across 74 countries. According to The World Food Programme (WFP). Factors such as climate change, war, and natural disasters like hurricanes and floods, exacerbated by the El Niño and La Niña phenomena, contribute to this situation.



In 2025, the Better Ramadan project focuses on 13 countries, including Malaysia, Palestine, Indonesia, Egypt, Nigeria, Syria, Jordan, New Zealand, Australia, the USA, Brunei, Turkey, and Japan. Alhamdulillah, the total distribution is estimated at 43,820 Iftar meals. Additionally, 1,636 Boxes of Happiness and 3,200 Qurans were distributed in areas like Egypt and Nigeria, and two water wells were successfully built in Nigeria.



With the support of the public, we are truly grateful for making this Ramadan a meaningful one for all recipients, in terms of Iftar meals, essential items, Qurans, and water wells that provide long-term benefits and change their lives. We hope that with everyone's support, we can continue to make future Ramadans just as meaningful.

Special Iftar For Ummah (SIFU)

Freshly made food to provide a balanced and nutritious meals to recipients, assuring they obtain necessary calories, protein, vitamins, and minerals that are needed by persons who are fasting during iftar.

Box of Happiness (BOH)

Box of Happiness is a MyFundAction initiative that provides eight essential food items—such as rice, oil, sugar, and salt—to support a small family’s nutrition for a month. Additionally, MyFundAction runs clean water well projects in countries like Malawi, Chad, Guinea-Bissau, and emergency water aid in Gaza. In Malaysia, this initiative is currently active in Gerik, Perak, supporting the Orang Asli community.



Waqf Al- Quran

Through the Waqf Al-Quran initiative, a total of 3,200 copies of the Quran have successfully been distributed to those in need, particularly in Egypt and Africa. These distributions were carried out as follows: Masjid al-Hadi al-Basyir, Pusat Pengajian al-Arab – 200 Qurans, Masjid Bilal bin Rabah – 200 Qurans, Kafr Ali Badrah, Dahqaliyah – 200 Qurans, 28 March: Masjid Rahmah, Qalyubia – 2,300 Qurans. These copies of the Quran were given especially to individuals in need, many of whom are committed to writing and memorizing the Quran despite living in difficult circumstances and lacking basic resources.



Water Well

Alhamdulillah, through the blessings of Ramadan this year, we successfully completed the construction of two water wells in Nigeria to provide access to clean water for the local communities. As widely known, Nigeria faces significant challenges in terms of nutrition and access to clean water. These water wells serve as a crucial resource to help alleviate their hardships and improve their daily lives.
